Ash Wednesday Mass Times

Ash Wednesday Masses will be held at 8:30 a.m., 12 p.m. and 7 p.m. All Catholics are highly encouraged to participate, although this day on the liturgical calendar is not a holy day of obligation.

Fasting Guidelines for Roman Catholics

All Catholics 14 years and older must abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Catholics between ages 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. To fast means to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken for good health but together they should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted; however, liquids including coffee, milk and fruit juices are allowed. Click the links below for more information.
